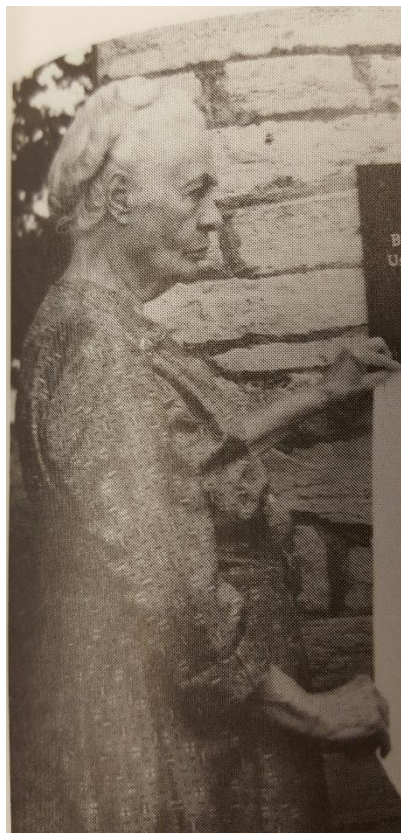

## ***Myrta Moody Circle***

**Who was Myrta Moody and why is there a UMW circle named for her??**

**What does the circle do??**

**Who can belong to Myrta Moody Circle??**



Myrta Moody was a member of John Stewart UMC for over 70 years. Throughout her lifetime, Myrta served God and John Stewart UMC faithfully in many capacities. She taught Sunday school in the primary department for 55 years and began the Cradle Roll to which for 46 years she happily added the name of each new baby born to a church member.

She was a long-time member of United Methodist Women and in 1951 a circle was named after her. In 1960 Myrta Moody was one of the church members chosen to unveil the plaque on the Old Mission Church when it became a national shrine. She died in 1967.

Myrta Moody Circle is an active group of women who are committed to supporting local, state, national and global missions with a focus on women, children, and youth. The circle meets once a month from September through April and each month has a program and a different mission focus. The September mission focus for the last several years has been to collect funds for school supplies for local children. Because school now starts in August, the circle has a fellowship “kick off” salad supper in August where monies are collected. The 2016 Salad Supper was held August 16 and circle members and guests donated \$115.00 for school supplies. The money was given to Open Door Resource Center to be used for backpacks and other school necessities.

Any woman who subscribes to the Purpose of the UMW may belong to Myrta Moody Circle or to either of the other two circles of the John Stewart UMW, Susannah’s Hope or Sisters in Faith, without being a church member. The Purpose of the UMW is:

*The organized unit of United Methodist Women (UMW) shall be a community of women whose purpose is to know God and to experience freedom as whole persons through Jesus Christ; to develop a creative, supportive fellowship; and to expand concepts of mission through participation in the global ministries of the church.*

Women are invited to participate in the monthly UMW circle meetings and/or to join with the UMW members in their mission activities. Attending meetings is not required, but the fellowship with women united in Christian mission will add much to your faith walk. Come visit a circle. You might like it!
